


Introduction:

Kingston Technology® manufactures two memory upgrades for Toshiba® Portege 3010CT and 3015CT series notebooks: KTT3010/32 (32MB) and KTT3010/32 (64MB).

Portege 3010CT and 3015CT notebooks comes standard with 32MB of (non-removable) memory, expandable to a maximum of 96MB, via the installation of a Kingston KTT3010/64 (64MB) memory upgrade module. Only one expansion socket is available.

Installation Procedure:

- 1. Turn the power off and disconnect all external cables from the computer. Remove the computer's rechargeable battery pack.
- 2. Carefully place the computer upside down on your work surface.
- 3. Remove the two screws holding the memory compartment cover in place and remove the memory compartment cover.



- 4. Carefully align the connector on your Kingston module with the computer's memory expansion socket. To do this, align the two screw holes in the module with the two threaded holes in the memory expansion compartment. When the module and expansion socket are properly aligned, the module will settle slightly into the expansion socket. Gently apply pressure in the area between the two screw holes (i.e., directly above the expansion connector) to seat the module into the expansion socket. Avoid pressing on the center of the module, which may cause component damage. Make sure the module seats completely into the expansion socket.
- 5. With the module installed, replace the memory compartment cover and secure it with the two screws removed earlier.
- 6. Replace the computer's rechargeable battery pack.
- 7. The newly installed memory will automatically be recognized by the computer.
