- The PortaCD portable CD211PE (10X) was the very first portable CD-ROM device with a PCMCIA interface that TEAC released to the retail market in 1997

Minimum System Requirements

- Portable IBM PC compatible Pentium 75MHz or higher
- DOS 6.22 or higher, Windows 3.1x , and 95
- 3.5" floppy disk drive for software installation
- PCMCIA card type II slot
- 850KB of available hard disk space for software installation
